


The following tutorial will explain how to schedule Delilah Holiday, Delilah Saturday and Delilah Sunday on your XDS Pro4-P satellite receiver, either for immediate broadcast or for later playback.

1. Access <http://myxdsreceiver.premiereradio.com> and input your serial number and password, both of which may be accessed from the front panel of the receiver itself.



Welcome to the Affiliate Website.

First-time visitors: Sign in using your receiver serial number and the daily password issued by your receiver.
Return visitors: Sign in using your receiver serial number and friendly password. If you lost or did not set a friendly password, sign in as a first-time visitor.



Passwords are case sensitive.

2. After entering your sign-in information, you will be prompted to choose the action you wish to perform. Select “View or Change my Schedules.” You will be presented with a list of stations assigned to your receiver. Choose the station on which you carry Delilah Holiday.



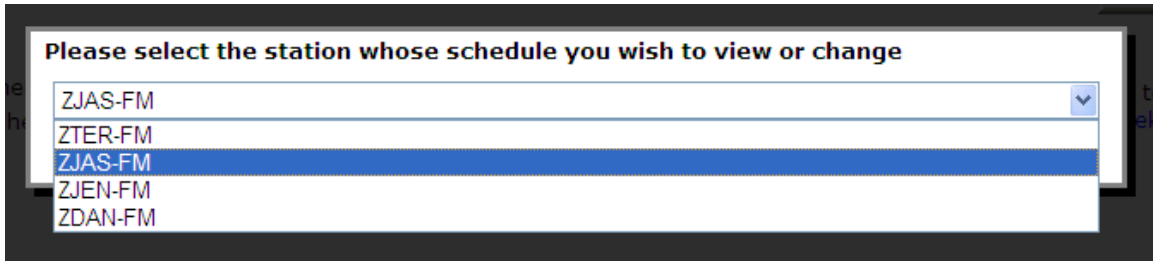

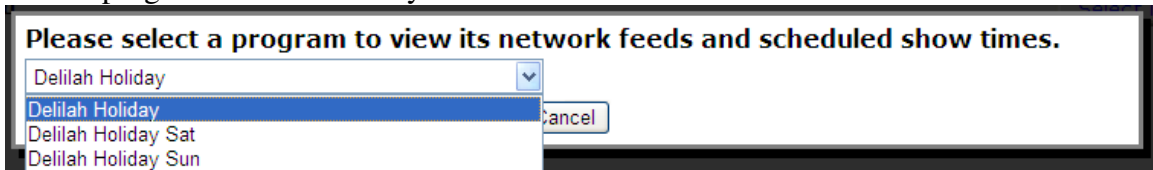
Set my Password, Time Zone, and other receiver options.

3. A calendar view of your programming schedule should now be visible. Click on the “Program List” tab at the upper left corner of the screen. You will see a list of programs authorized to your receiver:



4. Select the appropriate version of Delilah Holiday and click OK. All hours will be available for scheduling, as pictured below. Click “Create a new station schedule...”



5. The Schedule Editor is now displayed. If you wish to delay the show for a later time, click the “Broadcast the program delayed...” radio button. In the “Local Air Start” window, type in the time of day in which you wish to air the program. If you wish to air it live, leave the settings at their default except for the Start Date and End Date (see next point on this)
6. Edit the “Start Date” and “End Date” fields to reflect the dates you wish to air the show. Note that the End Date is the last day the show will air; for example, if you

enter 12/25/2009 (pictured below) the show will air on Christmas Day and revert back to the other feed on the 26th.

Set the Date Range of the network feeds to use for this schedule.

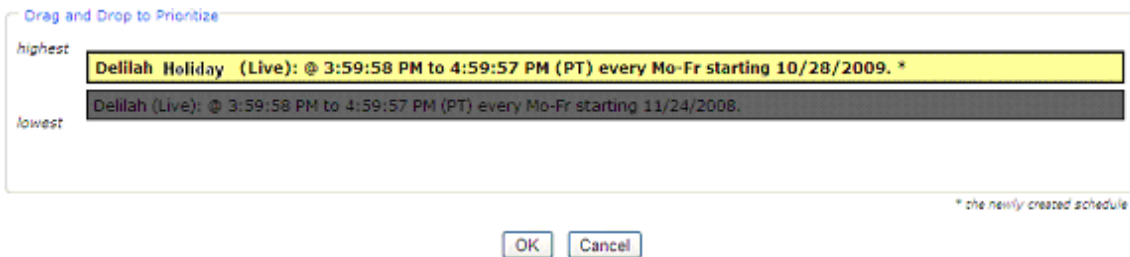

7. Click “Add.”

You will see the following “Prioritize Overlapping Schedules” screen:

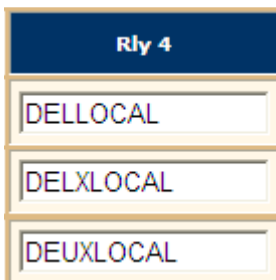


8. Drag “Delilah Holiday” to the top of the list and press OK. Show presence can be verified by clicking on “Calendar View” and scrolling down to the time in which it is scheduled.

RELAY MAPPING

While Delilah Holiday M-F, Delilah Holiday Saturday, and Delilah Holiday Sunday utilize the same relay functions as the normal feeds (indicated by common suffixes such as xxLOCAL, xxLINER1, etc.), they all have unique relay codes which must be mapped. These can be placed under/in addition to the normal codes so there is no need to delete anything that is already there.

For example, here is what Delilah Main (top), Delilah Holiday (middle), and Delilah Holiday Sunday (bottom) look like mapped:

A closing note: authorization for Delilah Holiday may outlast actual program transmission, so after Christmas it is highly advisable to delete the schedule. As the Delilah / Delilah Gold program is still authorized and scheduled, that show should air by default after this is done. Again, you can verify this by clicking on “Calendar View” and viewing the updated schedule.
