

On Monday, January 7th, Dan Patrick will begin doing Live Reads.

Excerpting from the program clock:

Network :60 at 16:00 & 57:50 may be Live read or produced spot. Relay 1 fires before produced spots or after Live read at 16:00.

When there is a Produced Network :60 or a Recorded Patrick-voiced spot scheduled instead of a Live Read, that spot will play just as it does now, after the :10-second bumper/ Relay 1 within the first stopset:

15:50 - Relay 1 & Bumper
16:00 - 2:00 Network break
18:00 - Relay 0 & 2:10 Local

When there is a Live Read, the break will be executed like this:

16:00 - Live Read :60 (within program content)
17:00 - Relay 1 & Bumper
17:10 - Network :60
18:10 - Relay 0 & 2:10 Local

Stations that utilize our relay closures won't be affected because it makes no difference to them whether the first network break is :60-seconds or 2:00 minutes.

Affiliates that use board operators to fire their local stopsets manually should use our relay closures, if not to fire the local break, then at least to fire an indicator light that will show when that local break begins. Otherwise, they will have to note whether Dan does a Live Read prior to the first break, or not, knowing that if he does, the network stopset will be only :60-seconds. When we use a guest host or run a best-of program, there will never be any Live Reads.

The fixed-position Local break at 58:50 will continue to fire on time regardless of whether a Live Read or produced spot precedes it.
